



BJCC Committee - President

Purpose

To be the face of the BJCC, representing the BJCC at public events, and being the main point of contact for enquiries regarding working with the BJCC. The President works to ensure that the BJCC's mission is communicated to industry, government, business and beyond, and that the views of BJCC's members are represented, giving voice to the BJCC in the broader business community.

Key Accountabilities:

President

The President takes accountability for the day to day running of the chamber, leading the Committee with ongoing decision making that aligns to the Chambers' mission.

Committee

- The President must ensure the good governance and integrity of the Chamber, and maintain its standing as a leader in the business community.
- Chair the BJCC Annual/ Special General Meeting, monthly Management Committee meetings and provide initiative updates to the broader Committee.
- Lead with the broader Committee to establish an event schedule that provides opportunities to connect, educate and advocate for Members.

Stakeholder Management

- The President is the key contact for all Sponsorship and Corporate Membership and is usually required to be involved in these discussions.
- The President must ensure the reputation of the Chamber remains positive and professional.

Ambassadors

- Lead with the Ambassador program, including, selection, onboarding and offboarding Ambassadors
- Regularly engage with Ambassadors, including monitoring (sometimes via Committee members) contributions to events and initiatives

Advocacy

Advocacy forms a key pillar to the ongoing growth and success of the Chamber. This involves building key relationships with other industry bodies, chambers of commerce, and any other identified individuals and entities important to the future of the chamber. Ideal elements to this role include the following:



- performing research on current landscape of influential and important decision makers and leaders
- collaborate with Committee and Ambassadors to keep audience informed
- seek out further potential advocacy elements to be researched and explored further
